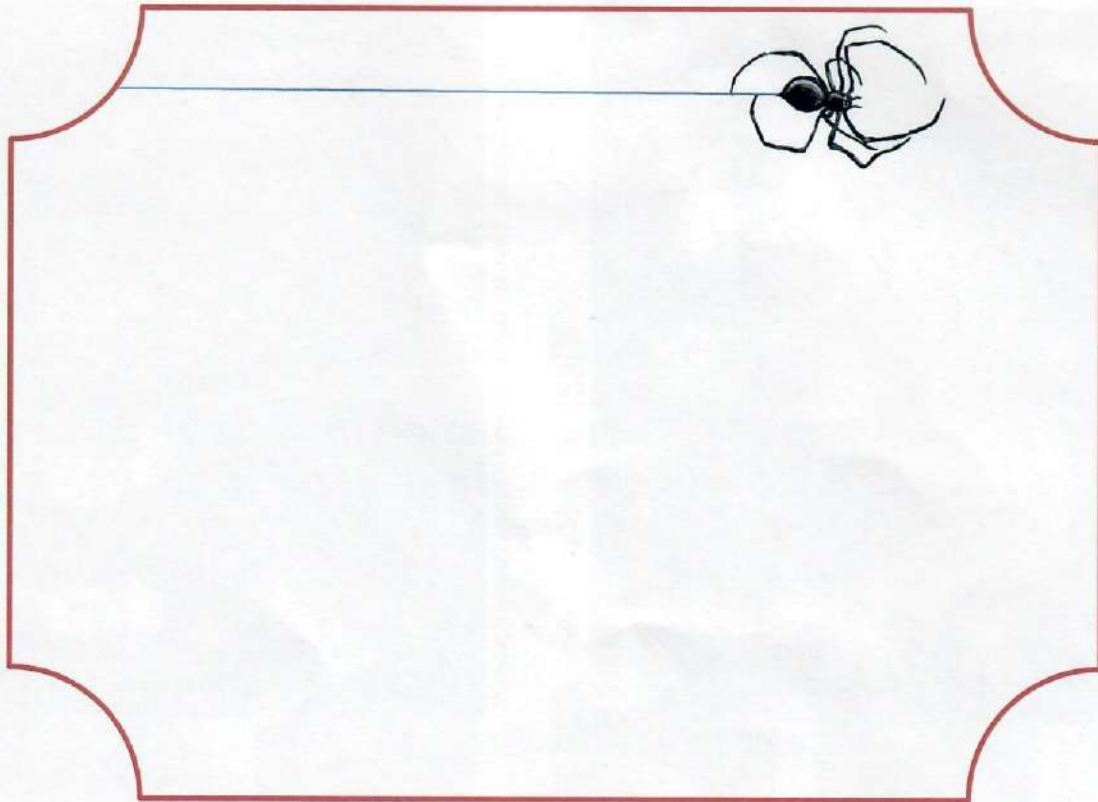
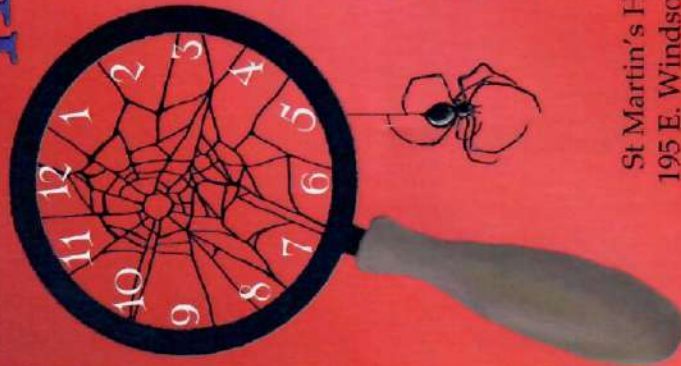

Those with severe arachnophobia should probably avoid the aisle seats. There will be cast in the aisle periodically. There will be strobe lights and a fog machine.

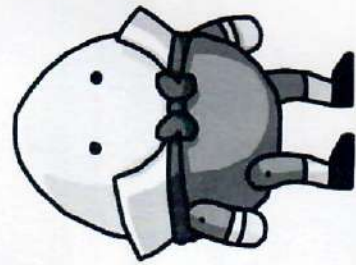
